Fields of activity:

The International Peace Worker will be located together with three colleagues in our KURVE cooperation and coordination office in Al-Walajah (close to Bethlehem and Jerusalem) and will work with several partners in their respective locations, mostly in Israel.

Content key aspects:

Consultation, support and backstopping of nonviolent initiatives, mostly in Israel, particularly in the fields of human rights, media, networking.

(possible) Fields of activity:

- Planning and implementation of the CPS-project within the team and with our local partners, integration into the team of our partners
- Support of organisational processes in program development or organisational development
- Identification and elaboration of our partners' requirements in capacity enhancing and process backstopping
- Project management: planning, implementation and monitoring of project activities together with our partners
- Organisation and implementation of trainings and networking
- Support in planning and implementation of advocacy and lobbying activities
- Needs oriented development of psychosocial self-care approaches
- Ensuring proper finance management and reporting as well as continuous communication with the CPS country coordinator and the KURVE head office
- Contribution to and support of activities regarding the cross sector topic gender
- Contribution to the CPS country coordinator's continuous conflict and security analyses, close cooperation with the civil peace workers on site
- Contribution to comprehensive cross-organisational processes of CPS organisations



- Contribution to networking, public relations and information activities of KURVE Wustrow in Germany, as necessary
- University or a similar degree in peace and conflict studies, international relations, or another relevant field

Qualification:

- 1. University or a similar degree in peace and conflict studies, international relations, or another relevant field
- 2. Relevant advanced training in civil, nonviolent conflict transformation (e.g. training as civil peace worker, mediator or coach for conflict transformation)
- 3. Thorough work experience in international NGO, in preference in intercultural teams and/or abroad
- 4. Thorough experience in the area of civil, nonviolent conflict transformation and human rights and experience in or acquaintance with nonviolent social movements
- 5. Contextual knowledge and/or work experience in the Occupied Palestinian Territories and/or Israel are an asset
- 6. Strong cultural sensitivity, professional handling of sensitive issues and discourses
- 7. Experience in participatory planning and implementation of projects incl. PM&E, experience in project accountancy
- 8. Respectful, intercultural, sensitive attitude and ability to self-reflect; high degree of flexibility, good team-player
- 9. Experience with psychosocial self-care approaches or trauma healing an asset
- 10. Very good knowledge of English; knowledge of Arabic and/or Hebrew an asset
- 11. Readiness for official travels, possibly in difficult circumstances

Contractual conditions:

We offer a contract according to the German law for development aid workers (only for EUcitizens, incl. EEA plus Switzerland) until **31 December 2022**, on the condition of funding by the BMZ beyond 31.12.2020. The contract including a preparation period in Germany would commence on the **1**th **of February 2020**.
